

2290 - Owner Operators

All trucks must pay a \$550 tax once per year to the IRS known as a Heavy Vehicle Use Tax. Many people know it as the 2290 tax because you use government form 2290 to submit the information and make the payment. DBTI pays this tax for all company trucks and trucks which are being lease purchased from DBTI. However, if you are an Owner Operator who owns your own truck, you must submit your form and make your payment by August 31st.
